FRUIT TREES

Almond #5
Almond Hall's Hardy #10

APPLE

Apple 'Braeburn' (Sweet with a bit of tart; crisp; good for cooking and eating fresh) #7
Apple 'Combination' (Harvest time depends on varieties used; 3 in 1 Combo self-fertile) #5
Apple 'Combination' (Harvest time depends on varieties used; 4 in 1 Combo self-fertile) #5
Apple 'Fuji' (October; sweet, firm fruit) #5
Apple 'Gala' (August; firm, crisp, sweet fruit) #10
Apple 'Granny Smith' (September; firm & tart fruit) #5
Apple 'Golden Delicious' (October; self-fertile; crisp & aromatic fruit) #5
Apple 'Honeycrisp' (Sweet, slightly tart apple; very crisp & aromatic; ripens from mid-September to mid-October; keeps well) #5, #7, #10
Apple 'Jonagold' (September; not a pollinator; tart, firm fruit) #5
Apple 'Jonathan' (October; crisp & juicy fruit) #5
Apple 'Mcintosh' (Late September; sweet with a tart tang; apple-sauce) #5
Apple 'Northpole' (Late September; juicy, rich flavor; 10' tall x 2' wide; perfect for containers on patio's) #5
Apple 'Red Blush Fuji' (Just like Fuji, except with red skin) #5
Apple 'Red Delicious' (September; pollinize w/ Yellow Delicious white, firm, crisp, juicy fruit) #5, #7
Apple 'Red McIntosh' (September; pollinize w/ Jonathan; good cooking apple) #5
Apple 'Scarlet Sentinel' (Late September; mild apple flavor; great for growing in containers on a patio) #5
Apple 'Yellow Transparent' (June to July; firm, crisp & juicy fruit) #5

All apples will produce more fruit if another apple is planted nearby. Plant any two apple trees together; Jonagold will not pollinate any apple. Crabapples will also work as a pollinizer.

APRICOT

Apricot, 'Blenheim' (July; self pollinizing; considered one of the most flavorful apricots) #7
Apricot, 'Chinese' (July; self pollinizing; firm & flavorful; freestone) #5
Apricot, 'Moorpark' (July; self pollinizing; firm & rich flavor; freestone) #5
Apricot, 'Tilton' (July; self pollinizing; firm & flavorful) #5

CHERRY

Cherry 'Bing' (June; pollinize w/ Montmorency, Stella or Van; sweet cherry) #5, #7, #10
Cherry 'Black Tartarian' (June; self-fertile; semi-sweet; good pollinizer) #5
Cherry 'Combination' (Harvest depends on varieties used; self-fertile) #5
Cherry 'Lambert' (June; pollinize w/ Lapins or Stella; sweet) #5

Cherry 'Lapins' (June; self-fertile; sweet) #5
Cherry 'Montmorency' (July; self-fertile; tart fruit; good pollinator) #5
Cherry 'New Bing' (Self-fertile) #5, #10
Cherry 'Rainier' (June; pollinize w/ Black Tartarian, Lambert, or Van; sweet cherry) #5
Cherry 'Royal Ann' (June; pollinize w/ Montmorency, Stella or Van; sweet cherry) #5
Cherry 'Self-Fertile Bing' synonymous with Lapins Cherry #5
Cherry 'Stella' (June; self-fertile; sweet fruit; good pollinator) #5
Cherry 'Sweetheart' (mid-July; self-fertile; sweet, crunchy fruit) #5
Cherry 'Utah Giant' (June; pollinize w/ Bing, Lambert, Rainier, or Van; large sweet cherry) #5
Cherry 'Van' (June; self-fertile; semi-sweet; good pollinator) #5

MULBERRY

Mulberry 'Pakistan' (July; 2 1/2 - 5" long fruits; raspberry like flavor) #5

NECTARINE

Nectarine 'Flavortop' (August; self-fertile; firm & juicy fruit) #5
Nectarine 'Harko' (August; sweet, firm yellow semi freestone; exceptionally tasty) #7
Nectarine 'Nectababe' (July; pollinize with other peach or nectarine; rich delicious flavor) #10
Nectarine 'Nectazee' (July; self-fertile; sweet yellow flesh; freestone) #10
Nectarine 'Redgold' (August; self-fertile; sweet yellow flesh; freestone) #5
Nectarine 'Sunglo' (August; self-fertile; large, juicy fruit; freestone; good for canning and freezing) #5

PEACH

Peach 'Babcock' (July; self-fertile; tangy, sweet fruit, freestone) #5
Peach 'Bonanza' (July; genetic dwarf; self-fertile; freestone) #5
Peach 'Combination' Gleason, Frost, Red Haven, Veteran, Cresthaven #5
Peach 'Early Elberta' (August; self-fertile; rich, sweet, yellow flesh; freestone) #5
Peach 'Elberta' (August; self-fertile; Very rich & sweet flesh; freestone) #5
Peach 'Frost' (September; self-fertile; tangy flavor; freestone) #5
Peach 'Giant Elberta' (August; self-fertile; high quality fruit; freestone) #10
Peach 'Gleason' aka 'Lemon Elberta' (Mid July; self-fertile; richly flavored, free-stone peach) #7
Peach 'Hale Haven' (August; self-fertile; firm & yellow flesh; freestone) #5
Peach 'July Elberta' (August; self-fertile; excellent flesh; freestone) #5
Peach 'Red Haven' (July; self-fertile; firm, sweet flesh; freestone) #5, #7, #10
Peach 'Suncrest' (July; self-fertile; very sweet and tasty; freestone) #5, #7
Peach 'Reliance' (July; self-fertile; good flavor; freestone) #5

PEAR

Pear 'Anjou' (October; pollinize w/ Bartlett; fine flavor ripens after cold storage) #5, #7

Pear 'Asian Combination' (Housii, Shinseiki, 20th Century, Chojuro) #5

Pear 'Bartlett' (August; self-fertile; sweet flesh; good pollinator) #5

Pear 'Combination' (Harvest depends on varieties used; self-fertile) #5

Pear 'Comice' (September; richly flavored dessert pear used in gift packs; self-fertile) #5, #7

Pear 'Hosuii' (August; pollinate w/ Bartlett; juicy, sweet) #5, #7

Pear 'Kieffer' (October; self-fertile; crisp, juicy fruit) #5

Pear 'Kikusui' (August; pollinate w/ Bartlett; sweet, crisp) #10

Pear 'Shinseiki' (August; self-fruitful; juicy, sweet, refreshing and crisp; yellow skin) #5, #7

Pear 'Shinko' (September; golden-brown skin; sweet, juicy, flavorful, crisp; pollinize with Bartlett or Housii) #5

Pear 'Twentieth Century' (August; self-fertile; firm, juicy, crisp with mild flavor) #5, #15

Pear 'Winter Nellis' (October; firm, juicy and aromatic; keeps well; needs a pollinizer)

Flowering Pears (*Pyrus calleryana*) will pollinate fruiting pears.

PLUM

Plum 'Elephant Heart' (September; pollinize w/ Santa Rosa; good flavor) #5

Plum 'Green Gage' (July; self-fertile; sweet & juicy) #5

Plum 'Santa Rosa' (June; self-fertile; pleasing, tart flavor) #5, #10

Plum 'Satsuma' (August; pollinize w/ Santa Rosa; firm, juicy fruit) #5

Plum 'Stanley' (August; self-fertile; juicy, sweet fruit) #5

Prune 'Italian' (August; self-fertile; excellent purple flesh) #5

WALNUT

Walnut, Black (Rich flavor, give moderate water) #10

Walnut, Carpathian (October; good quality nut) #5

SMALL FRUITS

BLACKBERRY

Blackberry, Black Satin

Thornless, rarely suckers. July; honey sweet flavor; very disease resistant. #1, #5

BLUEBERRY

Blueberry, Hardibblue - highbush

Exceptionally sweet, medium sized berries produced in summer. #2

Blueberry, Northblue - lowbush

A large mid-season crop of blueberries produced. Zone 4.
Does not require a pollinizer. #1

BOYSENBERRY

Boysenberry

Bears fruit on second year canes in summer. High yield; sweet-tart flavor; use fresh, cooked or frozen. #1, #2

CURRENT

Current, Red

Cut stems older than 3 years to the ground. Summer bearing; tart flavor good for jelly, jams & preserves. #1, #2

GOOSEBERRY

Gooseberry

Cut stems older than 3 years to the ground. Late spring to summer bearing; used in pies & canning. #1, #2

GRAPE

Grape, Black Monukka

Cane or Spur pruning. Seedless. August to September; crisp, sweet flavor. Good table grape. #1

Grape, Concord Seedless

Cane or Spur pruning. Seedless. Slipskin. August to September; thick skin; excellent, strong flavor. Good for juice or jam. #1

Grape, Eastern Concord

Cane or Spur pruning. Seeds. Slipskin. August to September; thick skin; excellent, strong flavor. Good for juice or jam. #1, #5

Grape, Flame or Red Flame

Cane pruning. Seedless. July; red skin; firm & good quality. #1, #2

Grape, Himrod

Cane pruning. Seedless. Good for arbors. August to September; yellow fruit; good table grape. #1, #2

Grape, Niagara

Cane pruning. Seeds. August to September; sweet, tangy flavor; excellent for arbors. #1, #2

RASPBERRY

Raspberry, Canby

Bears fruit on second year canes. Cut canes out after harvest. Summer bearing; large bright-red berries; thornless. #1, #2

Raspberry, Cumberland

Side branches bears fruit second year. Cut canes out after harvest. Summer bearing; large black berries; heavy-bearing variety. #1, #5

Raspberry, Fall Gold

Fruit in first autumn on top 3rd of cane; again in 2nd summer on lower 2/3 of cane. Everbearing; large yellow fruit with good flavor. Cut canes out after harvest. #1

Raspberry, Heritage

Fruit in first autumn on top 3rd of cane; again in 2nd summer on lower 2/3 of cane. Everbearing; small red berries are tasty. Cut canes out after harvest. #1, #2

Raspberry, Indian Summer

Fruit in first autumn on top 3rd of cane; again in 2nd summer on lower 2/3 of cane. Everbearing; large, tasty red berries; fall crop is often larger than summer. #1

Raspberry, Latham

Bears fruit on second year canes. Cut canes out after harvest. Summer bearing; red berries are crumbly. #1
