



## BAMBOO

### **Green Panda'**

*Fargesia rufa*

6-8' tall. Clumping to 5' wide.  
Prefers part shade to shade.  
Narrow stems less than 1/2" wide.  
Hardy to -15.

### **Sunset Glow'**

*Fargesia rufa*

8' tall. Clumping to 8' wide.  
Prefers part shade.  
Narrow stems less than 1/2" wide.  
Hardy to -20.

### **Golden Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys aurea*

10' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade to sun.  
1.5" stems  
Hardy to 0.

### **Yellow Groove Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys aureosulcata*

15' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
1.5" stems  
Hardy to -20.

### **Crookstem Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys aureosulcata alata*

20' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
2" stems.  
Hardy to -10.

### **Castillon'**

*Phyllostachys bambusoides*

15' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
2" stems.  
Hardy to 0.

### **Japanese Timber Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys bambusoides*

15' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
6" stems.  
Hardy to 0.

### **Bisset Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys bissettii*

20' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
1.5" stems  
Hardy to -10.

### **Black Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys nigra*

8' tall or more. Running.  
Part shade.  
1.5" stems  
Hardy to 0.

### **Henon'**

*Phyllostachys nigra*

20' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
3" stems.  
Hardy to 0.

### **Naked Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys nuda*

20' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
2" stems.  
Hardy to -15.

### **Vivax Bamboo**

*Phyllostachys vivax*

25' tall or more. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
5" stems.  
Hardy to -5.

### **Dwarf Bamboo**

*Pleioblastus pumilis*

3-4' tall. Running.  
Prefers part shade.  
1/4" stems.  
Hardy to -10.

### **Japanese Arrow Bamboo**

*Pseudosasa japonica*

6-10' tall or more. Running.  
Shade to part shade  
3/4" stems.  
Hardy to 0.

### **Palmate Bamboo**

*Sasa palmata*

5-8' tall. Running. Fast spreading.  
Shade tolerant  
3/8" stems  
Hardy to 0.

### **Red Fastuosa Bamboo**

*Semiarundinaria fastuosa*

8-10' tall. Running. Slow spreading.  
Prefers part shade.  
1.25" stems.  
Hardy to -5.
