CUCUMBER VARIETIES

The following varieties are commonly grown by local growers-however their availability will vary.

SLICER TYPE	<i>Days to Maturity</i>	<i>Length</i>	<i>Comment</i>
<i>Armenian</i>	65	12-18"	<i>Heirloom. Thin skinned, dense flesh, few seeds, burpless, no peeling necessary.</i>
<i>Burpless Bush</i>	55	10"	<i>More compact plant. Dark green, sweet firm. Disease resistant.</i>
<i>Burpless Hybrid</i>	55	10"	<i>Dark green, sweet, never bitter, very productive. Disease resistant.</i>
<i>Diva</i>	58	6-8"	<i>All American Seletion. Good yields, not bitter, burpless, seedless. Disease resistant</i>
<i>Fan Fare</i>	63	8-9"	<i>All American Seletion. Compact plant. Excellent yields, high quality fruit.</i>
<i>Japanese Cucumber</i>	57	9"+	<i>Long, dark green, smooth skin. Crisp, sweet and juicy.</i>
<i>Lemon</i>	65	Baseball size	<i>Lemon yellow, excellent flavor, sweet, good for salads or pickling. Non bitter skin.</i>
<i>Salad Bush</i>	57	6-7"	<i>Compact plants, good in containers. Very productive.</i>
<i>Straight Eight</i>	58	7-8"	<i>Early, dark green, vigorous and productive. Good slicing variety.</i>
<i>Sweet Slice</i>	62	10-12"	<i>Sweet, not bitter, burpless, no need to peel. Disease resistant.</i>
<i>Sweet Success</i>	60	12-14"	<i>All American Selection. Early maturing, not bitter, burpless. Disease resistant.</i>

PICKLING TYPE

<i>Bush Pickle</i>	45	5"	<i>Compact plant, good for containers. Cool, mild flavor. Disease resistant.</i>
<i>Cool Breeze</i>	45	4"-5"	<i>Heavy yield, smooth skin, nearly seedless, Does not need cross pollination.</i>
<i>Homemade Pickles</i>	55	2-6"	<i>Perfect for pickles. Solid crisp flesh. Vigorous. Disease resistant.</i>
<i>National Pickling</i>	55	6"	<i>Heirloom. Well shaped, firm. White flesh, perfect for pickling, Popular variety.</i>
<i>Wisconsin SMR58</i>	60	6"	<i>Straight and uniform. Vigorous, high producing, excellent quality. Disease resistant.</i>
