The following varieties are commonly grown by local growers-however their availability will vary.

MELONS	<i>Days to Maturity</i>	<i>Type</i>	<i>Comment</i>
<i>Ambrosia</i>	86	<i>Cantaloupe</i>	<i>Luscious, sweet an juicy. High yields. Resistant to powdery mildew.</i>
<i>Amy Hybrid</i>	70	<i>Hybrid Persian</i>	<i>All American Selection. Gold skin, white flesh. Sweet, juicy fruit. Adaptive.</i>
<i>Burpee Hybrid</i>	82	<i>Cantaloupe</i>	<i>Thick, firm and juicy. Delicious flavor. High yields</i>
<i>Crenshaw</i>	107	<i>Hybrid-Casaba/ Persian</i>	<i>Fragrant, sweet, succulent flesh. Skin is yellowish green when ripe.</i>
<i>Earlydew Hybrid</i>	80	<i>Honeydew</i>	<i>Vigorous and disease resistant. High sugar content. Heavy producer.</i>
<i>Fastbreak Muskmelon</i>	65	<i>Cantaloupe</i>	<i>Excellent flavor and sweetness. Resists wilt. High yields.</i>
<i>Hale's Best</i>	90	<i>Cantaloupe</i>	<i>Sweet, juicy and aromatic. Excellent flavor.</i>
<i>Honeydew</i>	95	<i>Honeydew</i>	<i>Sweet and juicy light green flesh. Excellent flavor.</i>
<i>Muskmelon-Hybrid Classic</i>	80	<i>Cantaloupe</i>	<i>Early, sweet, thick flesh. Wilt resistant vines.</i>
<i>Sugar Nut Hybrid</i>	80	<i>Hybrid Persian</i>	<i>Bright yellow skin, greenish yellow flesh. Very sweet and juicy.</i>

WATERMELON

<i>Crimson Sweet</i>	80	<i>Watermelon</i>	<i>25 lbs. Fruit. Deep red flesh. Sweet. Almost seedless. Disease resistant.</i>
<i>Moon & Stars</i>	85	<i>Watermelon</i>	<i>25-30 lbs. Green with yellow spots. Pinkish red flesh is extra sweet.</i>
<i>Sugar Baby</i>	85	<i>Watermelon</i>	<i>6-10 lbs. Compact variety. Rich, sweet flavor. Productive, disease resistant.</i>
<i>Yellow Doll</i>	75	<i>Watermelon</i>	<i>5-10 lbs. Flesh is crisp, yellow, sweeter than others. Productive. Few seeds.</i>
